Wash your hands.

Clean and disinfect surfaces regularly.

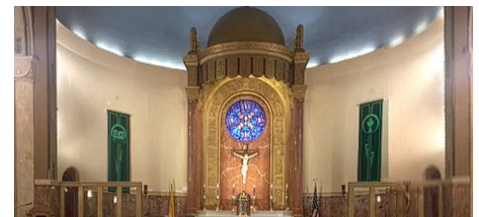
- Use a regular household cleaning spray or wipe to disinfect frequently used objects like keyboards, doorknobs, phones, etc.
